Commissioner Salinas made the motion to approve Resolution finding that conditions exist within the designated historic commercial district of the city which are detrimental to the public health, safety and welfare of the community and, therefore, are declared to constitute a blighted area.  - (4) Willacy County regarding the maintenance of water and wastewater distribution lines and water meters owned by the city.
 - (5) Willacy County regarding the maintenance of city streets and right-of-ways by Pct. #3.

- (6) Lyford CISD to allow city employees onto school property to maintain the water and wastewater distribution lines and water meters owned by the city.
- (7) Lyford CISD regarding the loan of equipment owned by each one.
- (8) Sebastian Municipal Utility District for the loan of equipment owned by each one.
