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GENERAL RULES AND PROCEDURES

VENDOR DEFINITION

- Food Vendor Vendor selling food and/or drinks to the public.
- Non-Food Vendor Vendor selling items that have been purchased for resale to the public.
- Arts and Crafts Vendor Vendor selling <u>hand crafted items</u> only
- Carnival Vendor Vendor with a game booth, kiddie ride or inflatable

CASH SALES –

The vendor registration fee is \$35.00, and \$45.00 if using electricity, which does not include health inspections (see attached registration) and limited electricity (if needed). Also feel free to bring a tent, table(s) & chairs for your booth not to exceed the space provided, which is 20'x10' per booth. Vendors are required to provide their own extension cord(s). Maximum of (2) outlets.

OBJECTIONABLE MATERIAL

Anyone selling or distributing objectionable materials to the public and not in conformity to the theme of the Christmas Festival will not be allowed to participate and will be asked to leave. The Lyford Police Department reserves the right to determine what is considered objectionable items. Objectionable items include, but are not limited to the following:

- Knives or toys resembling knives
- Lighter or flammable materials
- · Material depicting marijuana, illegal drugs, or drug related paraphernalia
- Stink or smoke bombs
- Items resembling cigarettes
- Any item or material not conforming to the theme of the Christmas Festival

Although these items may be considered legal for sale, the City of Lyford is concerned with the sale to minors. Vendors are asked to use good judgment and consider parental/guardian approval before selling what may be considered "objectionable" items to minors.
